



Instrumental Music Information for Year 7s

Baimbridge College offers a vibrant, performance-based music program. The music program is a very important part of the school curriculum at Baimbridge, where we believe all students have the potential to learn music.

The Music Program provides valuable instruction and teaching on a wide variety of instruments, as well as outstanding opportunities for skills development and performance.

At Baimbridge we are excited to offer our year 7's a range of instruments and lessons for free.

We also are lucky enough to offer performance opportunities with ensembles active in both the school and wider community.

There are also opportunities to attend camps, workshops and even music tours.

Instrumental tuition is held one period a week in a small group on a rotational withdrawal system from normal classes. Instruments and lessons will be assigned randomly at the start of year to each student to minimise the impact of withdrawal from normal classes. Requests can be made for a specific instrument, but these selections may not always be possible or practical.
